The secret is in knowing how to manage it all from the point of view of how much of external material, and or innate personal resources to apply in which direction, such that we come out, indeed, stronger, and even more resourceful, guaranteeing ourselves each our own personal optimal longevity on earth. Love is another powerful weapon on self-preservation for our main man, both in practice and conceptually.
