She channeled much of her inheritance, and her conflicted conscience, into a monstrous estate now known as the Winchester Mystery House, where she sought refuge from this ever-expanding army of phantoms. In this provocative and deeply-researched work of narrative history, Haaq fundamentally revises the history of arms in America, and in so doing explodes the clichés that have created and sustained our lethal gun culture.
